

NICOLAS AUVRAY GALLERY

Ayline Olukman is a multidisciplinary artist whose work addresses the notion of the unconscious, humanity and wandering. She uses photography, painting, writing and drawing. Born in Strasbourg, France in 1981, she graduated from the École des Arts Décoratifs in Strasbourg in 2005. Between 2006 and 2015, Ayline Olukman alternated between periods of work in her studio in Strasbourg and trips, which she considered like phases of research to photograph and write.

From this period resulted exhibitions in France, but also in New York, Brussels, Basel, London, Gothenburg, Shanghai or Istanbul and the publication of two books published by Médiapop, Small Eternity (2012) and America (2015), which combine texts and photographs. After a residency in 2015 at Point B in Brooklyn, she settled and worked in New York until 2018. In June 2018 she was nominated as a Voies-Off finalist at the Rencontres de la photographie d' Arles. In October 2018, she participated in the residency of the International Art Center of Shangjin in China. She won the Prize of the Verzasca Foto Festival 2019 (Switzerland), where she is exhibited. His third book, La Mue, published in 2019, is selected among the best photo books 2019 by the PH Museum. In 2020 she was nominated by Freelens for the Mentor Prize. In 2021, she will have a position as a photographer at the Chamber and the HEAR in Strasbourg. Her fourth book, Elysian Fields, will be published in November 2021 by Mediapop Editions.

About the series from the Artist's Statement

"On the road or by immersing the body in the natural elements, the accompanying series speaks of the desire for freedom. I wanted to make visual the fluid energy of nature that constitutes us and which also constitutes space and memories. For over fifteen years, I have been doing experimental work on images. I don't have a predefined protocol. Empirically and intuitively, I choose to invent a new narration for each work from my photographs transferred to canvas, then reinterpreted in color with paint and glaze. We follow a woman in a road movie that she creates for herself, contemporary epic of a world filled with nostalgia that she appropriates. The body is alive, exalted by the sensations of water, sun and air on the skin. It is a way of communicating that is pre-verbal: the painting is sensual, it's about intimacy. It's a desire to connect to something that feels both personal as well as eternal."















At Nicolas Auvray Gallery, connoisseurs and collectors are shown a broad selection of exciting artists allowing them to discover new talents.

Nicolas Auvray Gallery aims to support and encourage the creation and development of the artists through the promotion of the work in fairs, institutions and private clients from the proceeds of the artwork sales.

We are drawn to work and artists for whom the physical relationship to the medium is central to the approach and we are passionate about the tangible and material aspect of the media itself. In addition to hand printed silver gelatin prints done in the darkroom, we have a selection of artists who use alternative printing methods such as chemigrams and palladium platinum artworks, as well as photograms where the relationship between the light and the paper is essential. We seek to represent the dynamic range of photographic creation today, from conceptual photography to the re-invented traditional approach.

One common thread that links all our artists is their relationship with primary elements. We look for connections with light, earth, minerals, air, water or heat. We represent work of the highest quality and look for artists with strong narrative of their personal vision in their photographs, either autobiographically as with Jehsong Baak's "one last goodbye" or by a study of their own social environment as we observe in Wendy Paton's "Visage de Nuit" or with the cosmologic research found in the work of Antonia Kuo. Founded by photographer, fine art printer and ICP member Nicolas Auvray, Nicolas Auvray Gallery is based in New York.
